

Organizational Eligibility

Applicants must be based and operating in the United States or its territories and may be either a public entity or nonprofit organization that is tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code.



Use of Grant Funds: \$125,000 over 1 year

Allowable

- Project staff salaries
- Subgrants to project partners/community organizations that clearly align with the mission, goals, and budget of the proposal
- Consultant fees
- Data collection and analysis
- Meetings
- Supplies
- Activities related to fundraising and development
- Project-related travel
- Other direct project expenses

Not Allowable

- Direct services (e.g., restorations, screenings, dental supplies, lost revenue, etc.)
- Capital expenditures
- Lobbying
- Endowments, or scholarships
- A substitute for funds currently being used to support similar activities



Completing the Proposal

Please note, the portal does not auto save, and applicants should periodically save to capture progress. To save and continue working on your proposal, you can click "Save and Continue" at any time. To save and close your proposal, to submit it or return to it another time, you can click "Save and Close" at any time. To come back to your application later select Draft Concepts from the left-hand side menu and select Draft Concepts. Select the correct draft from the middle menu and the click Edit in the top right-hand side.

- Complete Organization Details Section:
 - a. Please note both the Primary Contact and Signatory must have a Fluxx account connected to your organization to be eligible to be selected.
 - b. Applicants must be based and operating in the United States or its territories and may be either a public entity or nonprofit organization that is tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code.
- Complete General Information by selecting the Sub Program you are applying for.
- 3. Complete Historic Funding section.
- Complete Proposal Information.
 - a. Please note your Project Start Date must be between 08/01/2024 09/30/2024 and Project
 End Date should be no longer than a full year from start date. (i.e., 9/1/24 8/31/25)
 - b. Amount Request should be \$125,000.00
- Complete questions 1 10.


