

COVID-19 Impacts on the Oral Health System



Study Design

- ...○ Surveyed consumers and patients in January and February 2021.
- ...○ Analyzed results specific to COVID-19 impact on oral health.



Results

- ...○ About 6 million adults lost their dental insurance due to the pandemic.
 - 65% have symptoms linked to oral diseases.
- ...○ 28 million adults delayed getting dental care due to
 - Cost of care
 - Lack of insurance
 - Fear of COVID-19 exposure
- ...○ 29% felt significant economic stress related to job insecurity.



Conclusion

- ...○ Longstanding barriers to dental care, combined with COVID-19, have created a climate of significant unmet oral health needs. To address this, we need to:
 - Expand dental coverage
 - Increase use of teledentistry
 - Offer preventive care
